We seek to empower young women to be strong and confident in their ability to become compassionate and courageous leaders of the future in whatever field they choose.

The development of a bespoke Leadership development programme will seek to draw out the girls' leadership potential, encourage them to have confidence in their individual leadership styles and feel empowered to step up to leadership opportunities.



Setting girls up for future success and high achievement through flexible and tailored academic pathways

Our curriculum programmes provide continuity, progression, flexibility and rigour for students aged 13–18 years.

- A broad and balanced Foundation programme builds strong foundations in language and core subjects and independent study skills to set girls up for success in their studies in Grade 9 and beyond.
- Our broad and flexible High School
 Diploma programme spanning Grades 912, with the additional option of
 preparing for academically rigorous,
 externally assessed exams (Advanced
 Placements, IGCSEs and A-Levels, IELTS,
 DELF, SATs), ensures each student's
 programme is tailored to their needs and
 goals beyond school and provides
 pathways for further study in the UK, US
 and university destinations around the
 world.
- Our creative and challenging Swiss Gap
 Experience programme broadens the
 perspective and skills of young women and
 sets them up with confidence and
 experiences which will stay with them for
 life.

The highly personalised approaches to teaching, learning and assessment, supported by detailed tracking, monitoring and reporting processes, ensure that each student is supported to stretch her potential and measure her progress academically and linguistically through her time at Surval. We use a range of internationally recognised tests to benchmark and measure student progress during their time at Surval in order to ensure they are challenged through a Surval education and in a competitive position on leaving Surval.

A structured and progressive careers and university guidance programme will be enhanced by external. international careers guidance and our inspiring speaker series, to ensure that students are making course option choices from an informed position and supported to work with their unique blend of strengths and talents to follow a pathway best suited to their individual goals and aspirations.

Developing strong global competence for success in a global workplace

As a school, we seek to be as culturally diverse as possible in our students and staff to optimise the global perspective of our students. The global diversity of Surval instils a natural international-mindedness in our students. As confidence is gained in languages during their time at Surval, girls switch happily between English and French, amongst other languages. Our focus on languages, culture, global perspectives and etiquette builds awareness and provides a strong platform from which girls can launch comfortably into whatever situation they may find themselves in future.

Surval will grow opportunities for networking and experiences beyond the school through membership of wider associations to enhance the global experience of girls and bring invigorating developmental opportunities beyond Surval for students and staff.



Creating powerful stories through adventure and challenge

A Surval education includes a richness of opportunities beyond the classroom – whether it be enjoying the beautiful outdoors environment skiing, hiking, cycling or on the water, or exploring the cultural and linguistic diversity of towns and cities in Switzerland and across Europe, or engaging in social enterprise initiatives at home and further afield. Girls are encouraged to step out of their comfort zone and embrace challenge in order to grow.

The development of the Surval Award will articulate and capture the impact of the full Surval experience and provide a lifelong record of a girl's experiences and achievements at Surval beyond the classroom.
